CAPTURING YOUR AUDIENCE



LOGOS

- Use Data
- Use Facts
- · Quote Sources
- Quote an Expert
- Provide Statistics
- · Give an Example
- Demonstrate (Add a picture)

PATHOS

- · Use a story
- Use the senses to help the readers understand more
- Use Figures of Speech such as metaphors or similes

ETHOS

- Appeal to the reputation of a country/ area
- Speak with authority and conviction
- Empathy make the readers 'feel' - sympathy, fear, anger

APPEAL

- · Desire of the readers to be heroes
- · Desire to do good and be good
- Desire to protect future generations
- · Pride in improving their country

MORE ADVANCED

- Attack Opposing views
- Include the reader by using 'You'
 'Us' instead of 'them'
- . Use Rhetoric Questions
- Provide Cause and Effect Arguments
- Use Humor and Hyperbole
